Set up & Play



Connect to power & turn the PWR/VOL button on.



Place vinyl record on the platter to play. Select the right speed 33/45/78 for your vinyl record.



To play cassette, insert cassette to the cassette tray following correct direction.



Press down the knob fully to eject. Press half way down to fast-forward.



USB port & RCA audio-out to connect with your external speakers.

Audacity Software Set up

Install software

Install the software from the CD disk or download the software from below web link:



Record Music to PC

Start to record



Power on the device and connect the USB to your PC's USB port.




Launch Audacity software on your PC.

Set up record "Preference"


To make your PC recongise the device & record the audio file properly. Please pay attention to the following parameters set up.

Software used to demo the operation is **version: 2.0.x**

Windows XP OS



Click [Edit] then select [Preference]




Under [Devices], select
[USB Audio Controller] from the list
as the recording device.




- Click record button to record

Windows 7 OS



Click [Edit] then select [Preference]




Under [Devices], select [USB Audio] from the list as the recording device.




- Click record button to record
- 2 Adjust record volume to max.


MAC 10.6+ OS



Click [Audacity] then select [Preference]



Under [Devices], select
[USB Audio Controller] as the
recording device.



- Click record button to record
- 2 Adjust record volume to max.

Save to PC

Click [STOP] button on software to stop recording.

Click [File] -[SAVE] to save the recorded file to your PC.

If you like to seperate each sound track. You can left click and hold your mouse to select the different length of the file and then save it individually.

Hint: usually the record signal is flat at the start point and end point of each sound track.

Play 45rpm Vinyl

Use 45rpm adaptor to play the 45rpm record if needed.

Replace Stylus

The turntable's stylus needle needs to be replaced every 3-4 months after continue playing.

go to www.mbeat.com.au to order your replacement.

Troubleshooting

1. Device is not power on?

Make sure that the main power is on. Make sure that you turn on the **PWR/VOL**. button and the blue LED is ON.

2. Can not insert the cassette?

Check if the cassette is inserted in the correct direction and there is nothing jammed inside the tray.

3. Can not play back the cassette?

Make sure the cassette is not jammed. Turn the cassette to the other side & try.

4. Noise from the speakers? For vinvl:

Check your vinyl track is not damaged. Check if your stylus needs to be replaced. suddenly increased noise or intermittent

sound are the signs of worn out stylus. For cassette:

Old cassette has little background noise due to its natural acoustic character and minor background noise is consider as normal.

or faded out.

Do not turn the recorder's speaker volume to the max. level in order to avoid sound distortion.

Check whether the tape track is damaged

5.Can not find the USB audio device when plug it into my computer?Refer manual "Set up record preference".

6.How can I playback recorded music?

You can play back recorded file using Windows Media Player or other media player software.
